Board of Supervisors,

The purpose of this proposal is to enter into contract with FLOCK Safety to provide License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras within the County of Amador. The use of LPR technology within the region and the state, has grown exponentially in recent years. Law enforcement, private business, schools, government entities and other organizations have utilized the system to provide potential real time information that otherwise could take days if not weeks to develop. This will increase law enforcement's chances of solving cases, recovering property, locating people and/or disrupting criminal activity within Amador County as well as within the State of California.

To provide you a few examples of how this technology has been used by our agency in the past, recently a piece of equipment was taken from the Plymouth/ Shenandoah Valley area with little to no leads on who took the equipment. With the assistance of an allied agency, who employs LPR technology within their county, the vehicle involved in the theft with the piece of equipment attached to it on a trailer was captured on LPR. That information was provided to our Investigations Bureau and subsequent arrest and recovery of the stolen equipment was completed. Without this investigative resource it would have taken an unknown amount of time to develop this lead, if at all, as the subjects involved in the theft were not residents of Amador County and were not known at the time of being involved in such activity by the Sheriff's Office. Furthermore, when the equipment was located, the subjects involved in the theft were in the process of disposing of the item and without the LPR information we might have never recovered the stolen equipment. This would have come at a financial loss, as well a production loss, to a business owner and resident of Amador County.

With theft being one of the major crimes committed in Amador County there are other examples in which the Sheriff's Office has used outside LPR technology to locate potential suspects and stolen items. The presence of the LPR technology within Amador County would provide law enforcement potential leads which could reduce the investigative process timeline and increase the potential of recovering stolen items and arresting the subjects involved in the criminal act. Another example of the use of LPR technology that is not involved in criminal cases would be that of a missing individual from Amador County or an individual who is missing in Amador County. During my time as a detective there was a report of a missing person, who was in a vehicle and had been missing for approximately 12 hours. At the start of our investigation the area of our search had a radius of 600 miles from Jackson, CA. There was no information on where the subject may have gone and with a search area encompassing the State of California, parts of Oregon, and Nevada, we did not have much to go on. With the assistance of an allied agency who had LPR technology, we received some location information for the missing subject that allowed us to narrow our investigation and notify the local agencies to be on the lookout for

the missing subject. Without this information we would have not known where to look for this missing individual.

In regards to missing individuals in Amador County, we are regularly notified by outside agencies regarding missing persons. The presence of LPR cameras within the Amador County could help the Sheriff's Office and outside agencies in the search for a missing person by reducing the investigative process in determining the subject's location. It should be noted when discussing missing people, that includes those who are voluntarily missing, kidnapped or trafficked. We can agree any one of these cases is a dire situation and the need to locate or aide in the location of the missing person is a priority.

In regards to recent fires within Amador County and the State of California, LPR technology has been used not only for following possible leads for arson investigation, but also assisted in the investigation of those who entered a disaster area with the intent to loot property. LPR technology within Amador County could potentially provide investigators crucial leads to apprehend potential suspects and quite possibly prevent any further destruction or theft of property.

These are just three examples in which LPR cameras would be beneficial in Amador County. LPR cameras have been used to reduce vehicle theft, narcotics/narcotics trafficking, search for wanted fugitives, identify potential victims, and reduce criminal activity, in turn increasing public safety.

One thing I want to make clear is that LPR Cameras are not a live surveillance system. LPR cameras take point-in-time, still images focused on the rear of vehicles traveling on public roadways from fixed locations. They do not monitor continuous movement. Flock does not utilize facial recognition and there is no ability to search for people in the system. Any vehicle that crosses its field of view will be captured, in a snap shot, nothing more. This information is then stored for 30 days and if not flagged for an investigative purpose, it is hard-deleted and unrecoverable, unless Amador County Sheriff's office has downloaded the image as evidence in an investigation at which point it will be stored in our evidence repository system. Amador County Sheriff's Office policy section 473 outlines the procedures in which LPR systems can be searched and used for law enforcement investigations. It should be noted the LPR system can only be used for law enforcement purposes and requires a case or incident number attached to each search conducted. Routine audits of the LPR searches by the Administrative Bureau of the Sheriff's Office will be conducted for compliance to policy section 473. If any employee is found out of compliance with policy section 473 they will be in violation of Amador County Sheriff's Office policy section 340 and will be disciplined accordingly. The Sheriff's Office understands the sensitivity of this information and will safeguard the integrity of this information at the highest level as we do with the other available confidential information already available to our sworn staff. Additionally, any data captured by the LPR cameras is 100% owned by the Amador County Sheriff's Office and will never be sold or shared with 3rd parties by FLOCK Safety. Amador County Sheriff's Office will be in full control of sharing data with other law enforcement agencies within the State of California.

Attached to this letter is a 2 year contract quote with FLOCK Safety for LPR cameras within Amador County. At this time we will only be deploying 10 cameras as noted in the quote which will be fully funded by the Sheriff's Office through grant funding and partnerships with no impact to the general fund. Additionally, there is a sole source letter justifying the use of FLOCK Safety over any other provider. Furthermore, multiple FLOCK Safety cameras have already been installed by private businesses and private communities within Amador County thus bolstering the need to use FLOCK Safety.

It is the recommendation of the Sheriff's Office to move forward with the project and to be ratified by Undersheriff Jarret Benov upon successful contract negotiations approved by County Counsel, GSA and Risk Management.

WHAT IS LPR?

License Plate Readers (LPR) have long helped law enforcement solve crimes. LPRs capture computer-readable images of license plates, allowing law enforcement agencies to compare plate numbers against those of stolen cars or cars driven by people suspected of being involved in criminal activities.

The information by LPR cameras can help determine whether a vehicle was at the crime scene and discover cars that may be associated with each other. Law enforcement agencies can choose to share their information with other agencies. The cameras can also integrate data from national or state crime databases to provide realtime alerts when a vehicle associated with a known suspect or a stolen vehicle passes the camera.

According to the National Conference of State Legislatures, when employed ethically and objectively, LPRs are an effective force-multiplying tool for law enforcement. A 2011 study by the Police Executive Research Forum concluded that LPRs used by Mesa, Ariz., Police resulted in "nearly three times as many 'hits' for stolen vehicles, and twice as many vehicle recoveries."

A comprehensive study conducted with oversight from independent criminology research experts found a clear correlation between Flock technology and increased case clearance rates.

WHAT IS THE FLOCK SAFETY FALCON®?

The Flock Safety Falcon® is a solar-powered, motion-activated, and infrastructure-free camera that leverages Flock's proprietary Vehicle Fingerprint® technology to identify and take a snapshot of the critical details of a vehicle that passes by it.

The Flock Safety Falcon® captures the make, vehicle type, color, license plate (full, partial, or missing), state of the license plate, and the vehicle's unique features, including damage and after-market alterations.

They are connected to the cloud through LTE, like a mobile phone, and perform 24/7 in any weather.

Flock Safety LPR cameras leverage the FBI's National Crime Information Center (NCIC) federal and state hotlist, which are updated at least every 24 hours, to send real-time alerts to nearby law enforcement officers when a wanted or stolen vehicle is detected. Officers can then verify that information with their dispatch to safely make arrests and recover stolen property.

They also integrate with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children's AMBER Alert database to help locate missing individuals, and can be used in the event of a Silver Alert in the same capacity.



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WHAT MAKES FLOCK SAFETY LPR UNIQUE?

While traditional automated license plate reading (LPR) cameras are an effective crimefighting option, they are also extremely expensive. The \$10,000-\$40,000 price tag is unrealistic for many of Flock Safety's customers.

As a more affordable option, Flock Safety cameras employ best-in-class LPR and machine learning technology. Flock cameras have an intentionally short shutter speed, which allows the camera to start taking pictures in less than a tenth of a second following vehicle motion sensing and to capture multiple frames of a car traveling up to 75 MPH.

The camera's infrared captures highly-accurate, clear images day or night. The machine learning allows the camera to capture vehicle information beyond the license plate — valuable evidence like vehicle make, type, color, and unusual characteristics.

Additionally, Flock Safety LPR is infrastructure-free, powered by solar and connected through LTE. The flat annual fee covers installation, maintenance, data, security, and customer service.

Lastly, Flock Safety is in the top echelon of the industry for privacy, transparency, and security. The footage is fully encrypted and stored in the cloud. All footage is deleted after 30 days on a rolling basis, unless a democratically-elected governing body or official legislates a different retention period.

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HOW DOES FLOCK SAFETY'S LPR HELP PROMOTE TRANSPARENCY AND OBJECTIVITY IN POLICING?

Flock Safety technology is purpose-built to remove human bias from crime-solving. The LPR cameras and machine learning technology are engineered to capture vehicle characteristics, types, and license plates, which are then checked against state and federal records to ensure accuracy and minimize errors.

The LPR cameras take still images of cars passing through the lens (not video) and cannot follow or track vehicles once they leave the camera's view.

Flock Safety DOES NOT record names, phone numbers, or addresses and doesn't mark specific locations where people have been. There is no capability in the system to mark or annotate the locations of passersby.

Finally, Flock Safety is built to enable and encourage transparency, with several features that create robust audit capability. Both private and law enforcement customers must enter a reason for each search made through the Flock Safety system. That search history can be easily displayed for a community or law enforcement leadership to see what the Flock system has been used for.

Flock Safety has also created the first free, optional LPR Transparency Portal to serve as a hub for a police agency's LPR usage, data retention, and search policies. Any law enforcement customer can access the LPR Transparency Portal.

Flock Safety is committed to building technology, tools, and a team that treats all people equitably, regardless of race, ethnicity, class, background, and orientation. We believe that everyone has a right to public safety.

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WHAT IS THE FLOCK SAFETY RAVEN® AUDIO SENSOR?

The Flock Safety Raven® is an audio detection device that pairs with the Flock Safety Falcon® LPR camera for law enforcement who want to decrease response times and increase case clearance.

Unlike single-point gunshot detection and traditional LPR, which segment evidence into silos, the Flock Safety Raven® recognizes the sound of gunshots, immediately calls 911, and consolidates actionable LPR and audio evidence into one streamlined system so first responders can save lives and collect crucial evidence that solves crime.

HOW DOES THE FLOCK SAFETY RAVEN® WORK?

The Flock Safety Raven® provides law enforcement agencies an affordable, infrastructure-light option for gunshot detection. It wakes when it detects a gunshot and is connected to a Flock Safety Falcon® LPR camera, activating the camera when it detects a crime in progress to capture the vehicle(s) on scene, and helping police build a more robust case.

The Flock Safety Raven® is solar and LTE-powered and can be deployed to mirror the structure of your community.

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DOES THE FLOCK SAFETY RAVEN® CAPTURE PERSONAL INFORMATION?

No. The Flock Safety Raven® is intended to capture loud sounds indicative of a crime in progress, not human voices or conversations. The audio clip is only a few seconds long, not long enough for any meaningful portion of identifiable audio to be captured. Sounds and data collected by the Flock Safety Raven® are subject to the same privacy and security standards as that of Flock Safety LPR devices.
